A SCHOOL-BASED EXHIBITION FOR WORKS INSPIRED BY HAMPTON

- Eligibility:**
- ~ Any original piece inspired by Hampton National Historic Site may be submitted.
 - ~ Use any 2-dimensional medium: paint, sketch, photo, writing, collage, or mixed media.
 - ~ Each participant is allowed only one entry, which may not exceed 18"x24" in size.
 - ~ Exhibit will be installed with Velcro. Work should be matted or mounted on a light-weight backing. Stretched canvases are allowed. Framing is *not* allowed.
 - ~ Each piece must have a 3" x 5" notecard attached, with name, title, medium, school, name of teacher, and contact information (email and phone number).

Awards: There will be four cash prizes awarded for *Best In Show* at the following levels:
1-Elementary School, 2-Middle School, 3-High School, and 4-Teacher
All entrants selected to exhibit will receive a certificate of participation.

Submissions: Must be received by the BCPS Office of Visual Arts by Monday, April 13, 2015.
